Unfortunately, in the holy month of Ramadan, the prices were shoot 3 times higher than the usual rates, subjecting people to the extreme need for edible accessories because the basic grocery has become beyond their purchasing power. WPTG Foundation has reached people during this difficult time and observed their miserable conditions. People were highly pleased to receive the food boxes, they appreciated WPTG Foundation's efforts for humanity in their hard times.

Weaving People to Grow Foundation (WPTG Foundation) in collaboration with Alkhidmat Foundation distributed Food Boxes among 200 deserving and financially vulnerable families. The event was organized in the premises of St. Catherine's Girls Hostel, Lalkurti Rawalpindi. WPTG Foundation's office is also located on this premises. There were a total of 173 women and 27 men out of 200 beneficiaries. The beneficiaries included widows, persons with disabilities and diseases, particularly women suffering from chronic diseases such as cancer, families with accident patients and jobless persons starving at home due to zero earnings. The event had two rounds; 1) Keynote speeches by the Honourable Guests and 2) Food Bags Distribution by WPTG Foundation's Team among the 200 beneficiaries. The first round comprised of a panel of speakers; Mr. Rizwan Ahmed President of Alkhidmat Foundation, Team Alkhidmat Foundation, His Excellency Archbishop Dr. Joseph Arshad, Ms. Rubina Basharat Bible Teacher from Living Branch Church, Lalkurti Branch, Sr. Thecla Barkat and Ms. Sofia Garstin Board Members WPTG Foundation, Ms. Kiran Peter, Executive Director of WPTG Foundation and Volunteer team of WPTG Foundation.

The demand for grocery and food items has increased because inflation in Pakistan has skyrocketed, in April 2023 it surged to 36.4% (Reuters May 2, 2023), its highest level since 1974. The highest inflation rate has pushed people into ultra-poverty.

WPTG FOUNDATION'S ACHIEVEMENTS JANUARY 2022 TO APRIL 2023

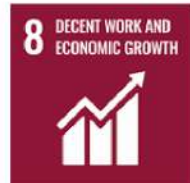
Thematic Area: Church and Community Development

- 400 poor vulnerable community members provided with Food Bags and Winter Kits (quilts, pillows and mattresses) in their difficult times.
- 5 poor widows provided with cash grants of PKR 10,000.
- 90 youth provided awareness on role of Christian leaders in the formation of Pakistan and in the Pakistan Defense Institution.
- Distributed 2 wheel chairs among disable persons belonging to extremely poor homes.



Thematic Area: Decent Work and Economic Growth

- 10 youth placed in reputation organization as regular employees.
- 369 youth provided with awareness sessions on importance of skill development and 101 completed their vocational trainings in graphic designing, web designing and development and plumbing.



Thematic Area: Promotion of Education

- 4 Youth and Children provided scholarships to restart and continue their education in schools and universities.
- 70 Youth and parents given awareness on importance of acquiring education.
- 32 out of School Children identified for the provision of Non-Formal Education.



Thematic Area: Climate Action

- 47 women youth and adults given awareness on preserving the climate and kitchen gardening.



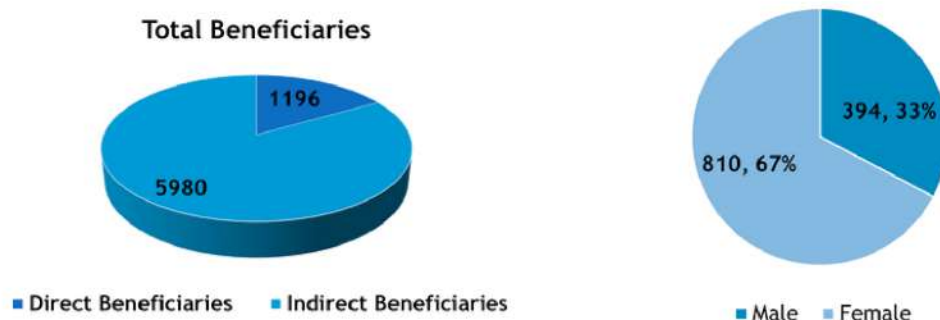
Thematic Area: Social Cohesion

- 126 community members mobilized on the promotion of social cohesion, peace and unity.

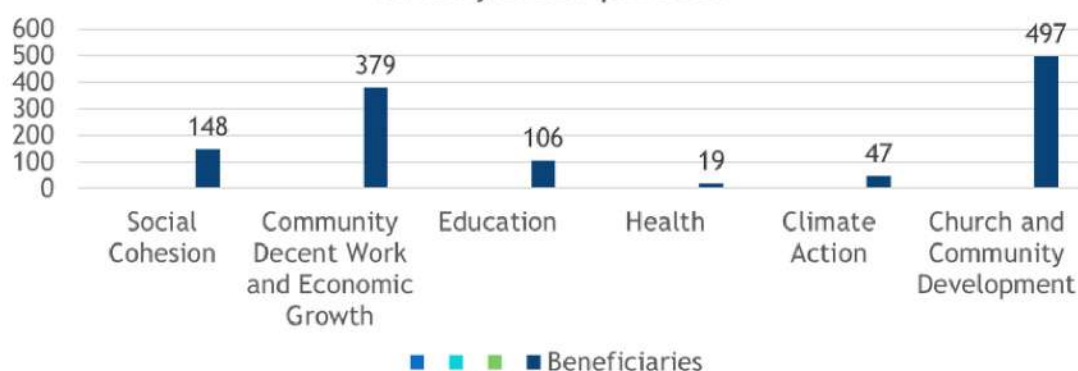


Thematic Area: Good Health

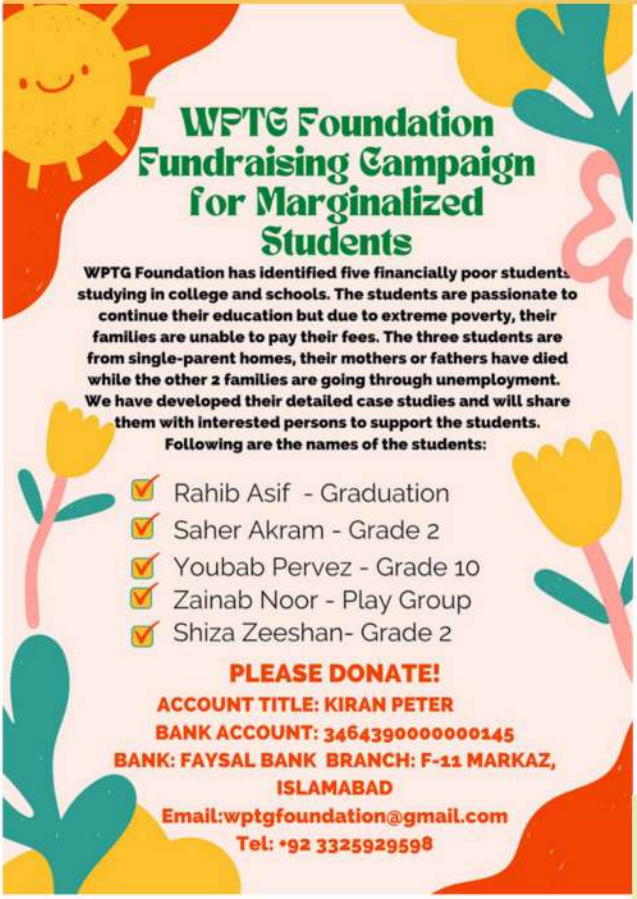
