WPTG FOUNDATION'S SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM (SDG 2 & 4)



WPTG Foundation under its scholarship program distributed scholarships to students hailing from families living below the poverty line. In the year 2023, Pakistan is facing worst form of inflation ever experienced in its history, which is exacerbating the financial conditions of the poor families particularly belonging to single headed parents. We are thankful to our generous donors who supported both of the girls in this difficult time. Rahib has gotten admission in NUML University Rawalpindi to study BS Accounts and Finance. Her dream is to work in a bank and help her father and a brother who got (brother) severe accident in 2020 and lost his leg. When Rahib was awarded scholarship her father said **"Yes, God hear the prayers"**.

Sehar's mother is a widow and meet her household expenses with huge difficulty. She was supported with monthly ration and educational expenses. Sehar father died in May 2022 due to cancer. She studies in class 2 and loves to be educated, therefore, WPTGF with its friends are trying their best to fulfill her dream.



NETWORKING WITH HOPE WORLDWIDE- PAKISTAN (SDG 17)

On January 14, 2023, WPTG Foundation networked with Hope Worldwide-Pakistan. The meeting was held with their Executive office team for organizational vision sharing and exploring common objectives to be worked on in future for the uplift of humanity and facilitate youth and marginalized families to live sustainable and dignified lives.

AWARENESS SESSION OF WOMEN ON KITCHEN GARDENING (SDG 13)

WPTG Foundation held an awareness session for 22 women at St. Joseph School in Mughlabad area of Rawalpindi. It was assessed during the session that only 2 women do kitchen gardening while the rest have never tried growing vegetables at home. WPTG Foundation helped women understand, the need of growing vegetable at home; firstly to eat healthy food and secondly to cope with growing inflation in Pakistan. These plants contribute largely in making the climate better. The women demanded for the provision of pots, flower beds, mud and seeds to initiate growing plants at home. They were also shown a video on ploughing seeds and making compost.



WPTG FOUNDATION'S VOCATIONAL TRAINING PROGRAM (SDG 8)



The 3rd badge of youth has been enrolled for vocational trainings in Buraq Institute of Science and Technology in January 2023. The students are learning the skills on graphic designing, web designing and development, basic IT skills, plumbing and quantity surveyor. The 40% youth who have completed their courses in 2022 are pursuing their careers in the similar fields. WPTGF does their mentoring and provide them career counselling telephonically as well.

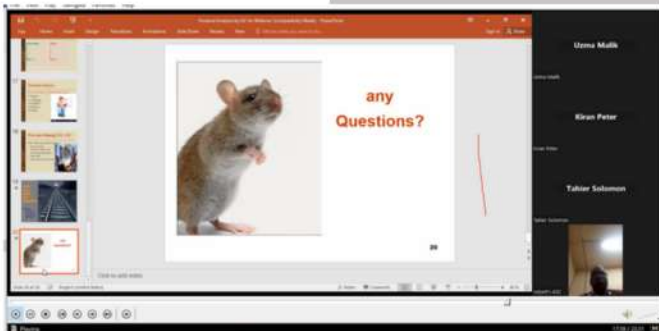
WEBINAR ON PERSONAL ANALYSIS (SDG 4)
