NETWORKING WITH JINNAH INSTITUTE

WPTGF networked with climate action experts and the Minister on Climate Action Ms Sherry Rehman at Jinnah Institute, a policy research and public advocacy think tank in Pakistan.

WPTG Foundation networked with Alkhidmat Foundation and distributed wheelchairs among disabled persons. These disabled persons belonged to marginalized families. Then after ten days of providing them with the wheelchairs, we asked them how this equipment has helped them. They responded that the wheelchairs have made them movable, and now they can move within their homes and also can go out to the market to purchase something or meet with their friends.

WPTG Foundation is thankful to Alkhidmat foundation for their gracious attitude to help people in need. We found their staff members very welcoming and respectful. We appreciate their collaboration and their passion for reaching out to the unreached through civil society organizations.

YOUTH VOCATIONAL TRAINING COURSES

The 2nd badge of the youth got enrolled in the Buraq Institute of science and technology from October 2022 until December 31, 2022. A total of 61 students have gotten admission in the courses of graphic designing, web designing and development, basic IT skills, plumbing and quantity surveyor.

The WPTG Foundation's Volunteers and Youth Network have played an integral role in approaching youth and motivating them to attend these courses.
