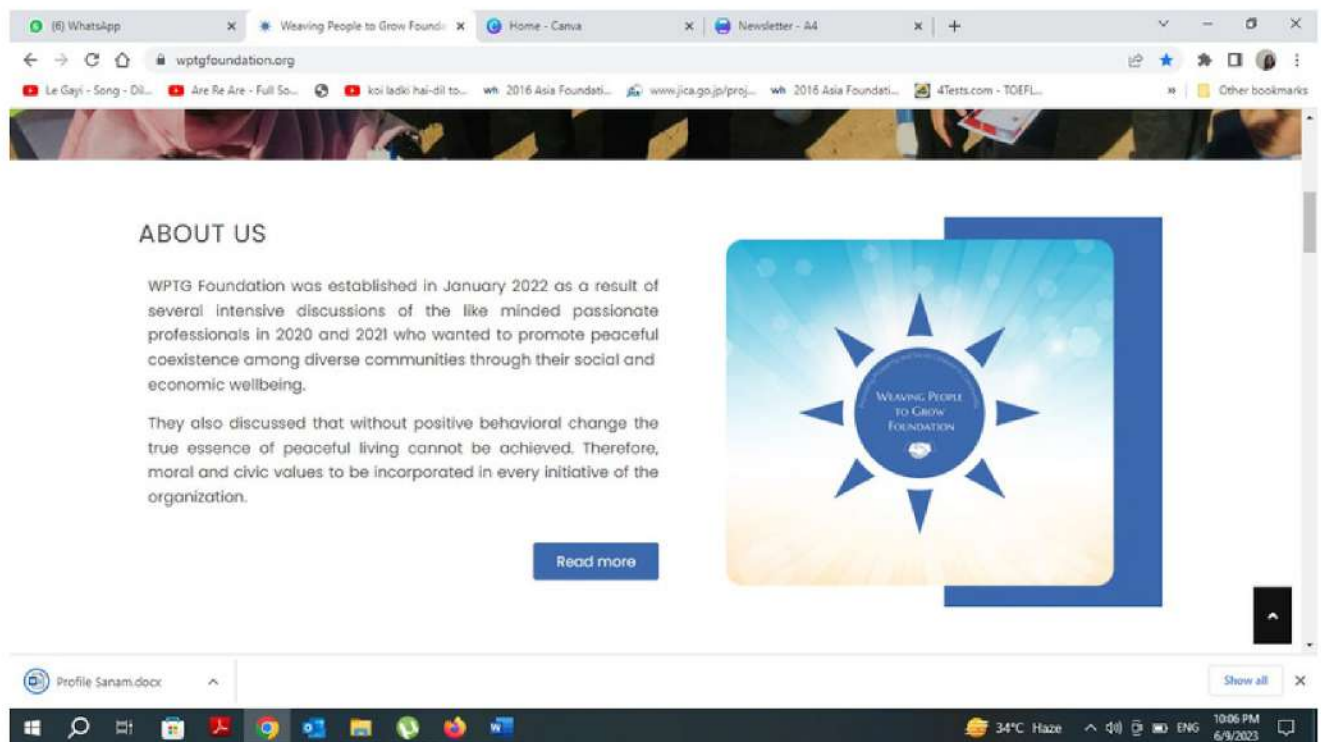

Accountability ensures those in positions of power, especially in government make the right use of their authority and finances. Accountability increases the legitimacy of a State. Many governments fail due to weak accountability mechanisms resulting in collapse of their organization's financial management and public service delivery.
