WPTG FOUNDATION'S NON-FORMAL EDUCATION CENTRE FOR OUT OF SCHOOL CHILDREN



Weaving People to Grow Foundation inaugurated its Non-Formal Education Centre (NFEC) for Out of School Children (OOSC) in June 2023 with the support of our International and national kind-hearted friends; Ms. Cornelia Reimer from Peace and Reconciliation Network and Col Zafar Uddin Ahmad. The project aims to provide free education to the financially poor children who have never been enrolled in schools or struck out of schools due to non-payment of their school fees. These children have crossed their Playgroup class age due to which the mainstream schools have refused to enroll them in line with their educational policies. We also have collaborated with the Pakistan Institute of Education (PIE) and the Japan International Cooperation Agency to strengthen our initiative of NFECs and they have provided us with books designed for NFECs at three levels; Level A, Level B and Level C. Level A for beginners gives classes from play group till class 1, Level B from 2 to 3 and Level C from 4 to 5 classes. Currently, we are having 14 OOSC studying with us; 10 of them have never gone to school while 4 were struck out of school during COVID-19 for not paying their fee for many months. The number of children will reach to 25 by next week. We are having one Lead Teacher and two Assistant Teachers to help these kids learn from scratch or beginning. The teachers have been provided with a Non-Formal Education Teaching Resource books which are helping them a lot to divide their course curriculum according to the set timeline to teach the complete syllabus to the children.
