WPTG Foundation held a Youth Discussion Forum on techniques of CV making and job hunting on October 21, 2023 at its premises. The speaker, Mr. Peter Paul Bob explained well how to draft a CV according to the job requirements and acquiring of networking skills to grab opportunities.

The following points were explained in details:

1. While writing your CV, focus on your skills and accomplishments. Reflect deeply on your past experience and qualities that make you stand out as a candidate.
2. Customize your application materials according to the job requirement.
3. To get a job, building a professional network is a powerful tool. This network can be developed by attending networking events, conferences, connect with professionals on LinkedIn and reach out to your contacts for advice and referrals.
4. Practice interviewing skills because rating for interview starts once you step inside the interview office. Therefore, always prepare for your interviews by researching the company, practicing common interview questions, and thinking about specific examples that demonstrate your skills and experience. Stay positive and persistent.

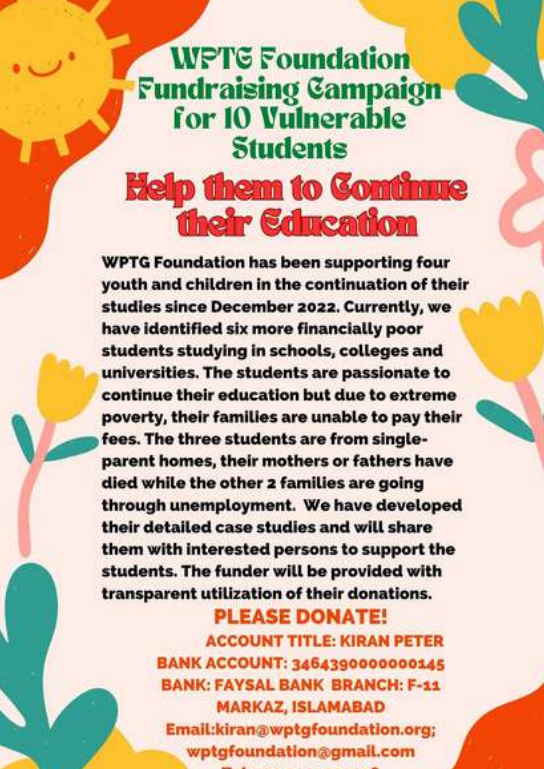
