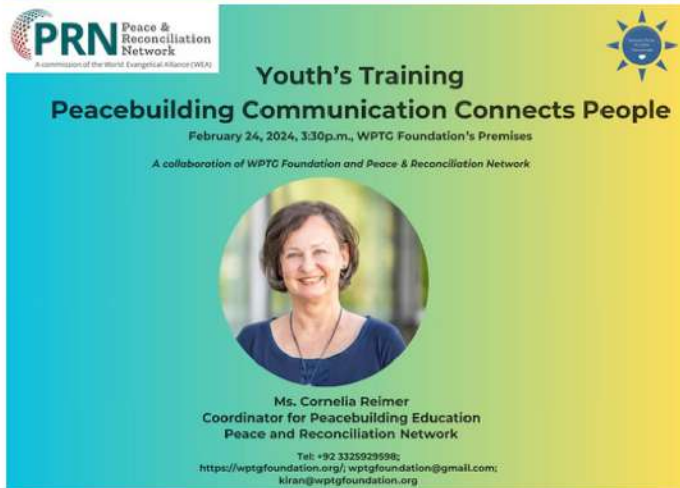

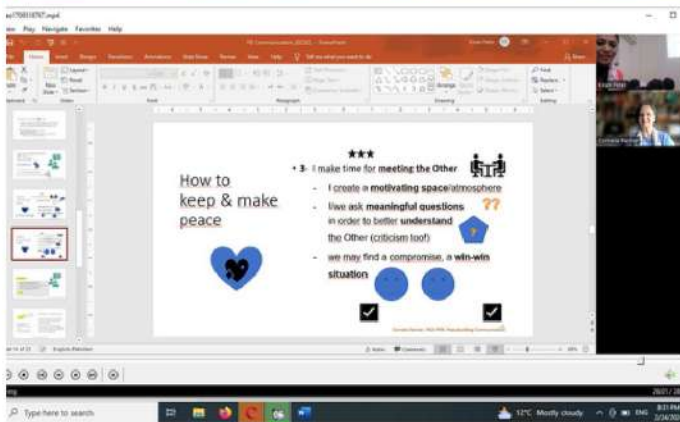


WPTG Foundation in collaboration with Action for Impact organisation conducted a session on interfaith harmony with Muslim and Christian religious leaders and community members on February 29, 2024. During the session, Ms. Kiran Peter the Executive Director of WPTG Foundation shared that interfaith harmony is a tool of peacebuilding aiming to promote peaceful coexistence among people of different religious beliefs. It is a notion to live and let live others. Interfaith harmony will strengthen our country from the inside and reduce the chances of civil war. It enables the society to become less aggressive and ponder upon the multidimensional development of the country. Interfaith harmony reduces mistrust, alienation and fears about people practising other faiths. We enrich ourselves by learning about others. It is important for diverse faith communities and religious leaders to learn it to retain peace in society. The participants discussed the concept of interfaith harmony in details by asking questions and clarifying their misinformation about the tool of peacebuilding. Under this project, the participants will be working closely with the law enforcement agencies in Islamabad to promote peace and harmony in their respective areas. Ms. Zartasha, the Executive Director of Action for Impact organization invited Ms. Kiran Peter to distribute certificates among participants.

WARM CLOTHES DONATION TO UPCHURCH SATELLITE TOWN



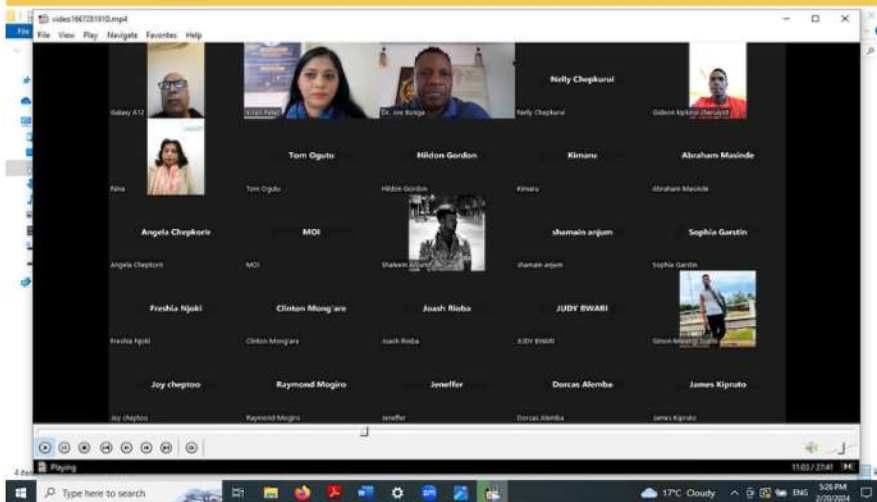
