The children enjoy music class on every Friday and learn peace songs and climate protection songs.

The children belongs to Christian, Muslim and Hindu religions we are teaching them to build relationship by sharing and caring one another because we all are humans created by God.

Networking Meeting with Japan International Aid Agency (JICA)



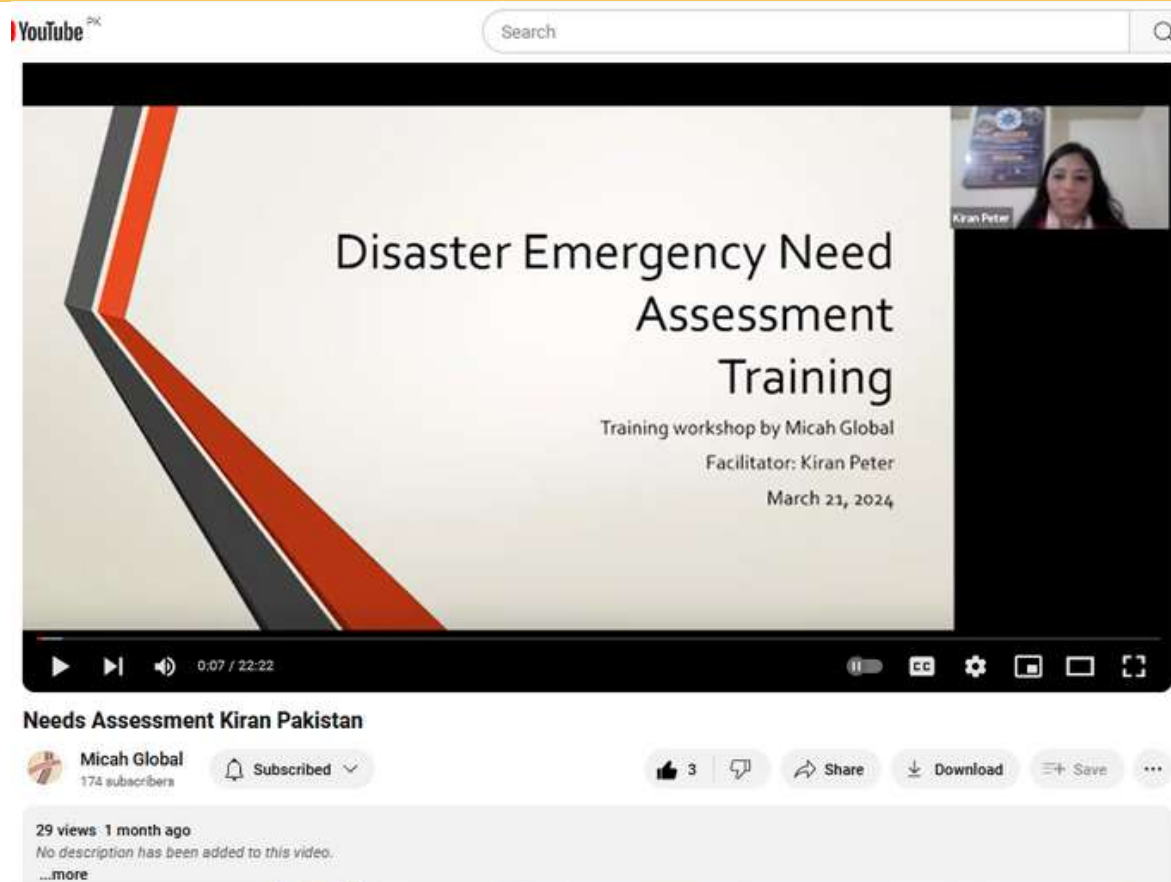

Awareness Raising of Youth on Gender Empowerment



Ms. Kiran Peter the Executive Director of WPTG Foundation is thankful to Outreach Assistance To Humanity - OATH organization for inviting her to conduct a session on preventing Gender Based Violence with the youth of Jesus of Nasrat Church, Christian Colony Chak Jalal Din Rawalpindi. This year International Women's Day theme "Inspire Inclusion" was also discussed in detail with them. During the questions and answers round of the session the youth discussed GBV issues in detail encountering them at individual and community level. The speaker, Oath team and youth collectively discussed the solutions relating to GBV. It was a remarkable and thought provoking session for men and boys who participated in the event.

WPTG FOUNDATION Beautician's Training Centre

WPTG Foundation launched its Beautician's Training Centre in September 2023. Ms. Sofia Garstin the Instructor of this Centre has provided a remarkable six months training to 15 women who used to earn PKR 3000 monthly. Now, the women maintain their monthly income book and the women have reported their income has raised to PKR 8000 to 10,000 monthly due to beautician's skills. WPTG Foundation also deals with daily customers and some percentage of its earnings goes to WPTG Foundation's Non-Formal Education Centre to provide free education to children.

The women have also reported use of conflict resolution techniques at home to resolve their day to day disagreements and conflicts.

The women also get chance to chat with one another in the beautician's training centre.
